to reduce suicide and improve mental health**.

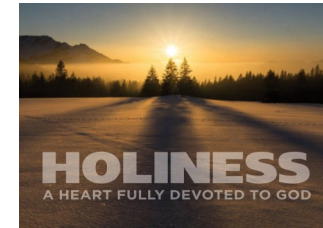
